## Welcoming Act in Crisis

In February of this year the Unified Government of Wyandotte County passed a historic legislature that would allow undocumented residence to get a county ID card. This would allow them to report crimes and not fear repercussions from routine stops by police on non-criminal offenses to be reported to ICE. Topeka has quickly began working on legislature to overturn it and it passed the house yesterday. They are falsely labeling Kansas City, Kansas a “sanctuary city.” Please help us to stop this nonsense. There is absolutely no attempt to harbor criminals in our county. Anyone with a criminal offense is reported immediately to ICE. Please help us overturn House Bill 2717! The affects so many areas of immigrant life, the most dangerous being the fear of reporting crimes. Please call your state senator today and tell them to vote no on HB2717
